- Photocopies of entry forms without the AKC Agreement are not acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are not acceptable.
- If you would like confirmation that your entry was received before the trial has closed, please include your email address or enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope.
- Entries cannot be changed once the trial has closed.

Please check your entries and confirmation!

Rottweiler Preference Period

From trial opening on 3/6 until 8am on 3/20, only Rottweiler entries will be put into the trial. Entries for all other breeds will be put on a wait list in the order in which they were received. On March 20, all other entries will be added to the trial until the 350-run limit is reached, and the rest will be on a wait list.

No special consideration can be given to Rottweiler entries received after 8:00am on March 20, 2023.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen 15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs with a PAL/ILP number or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

Obstacles

Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

"After Closing" Waiting List

A waiting list (30 run maximum each day) will be maintained for these trials once they have closed on April 10. The waiting list will be active until its deadline – Monday, May 15, 2023, at 6:00 pm CT. Any runs that are entered in these trials at closing and pulled before the waiting list deadline will be replaced, if possible, by runs in order on the waiting list, and the exhibitor will be reimbursed in full. If a run cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the run. Entry fees for runs on the waiting list that do not get into the trial by the waiting list closing date will be refunded in full.

AKC Jump Height Cards

All dogs competing in agility must **possess** an official AKC Jump Height Card. **You are not required to show your height card or send a copy with your entry. You <u>are required</u> to mark on your entry form if your dog needs to be measured. For more information please visit: http://www.akc.org/events/agility/jump_height_card.cfm**

Move-Ups

For the Wednesday trial: MOVE-UPS close at 6:00 pm CT, Wednesday, May 17. Move-ups may be sent by regular mail or email to the Trial Secretary. If an email address is provided with your entry, an email confirmation of the move-up will be sent. For the Thursday and Friday trials: MOVE-UPS close 30 minutes after the end of the trial on Wednesday and Thursday respectively and must be submitted at the trial. Mailed/emailed move-ups close at 6:00 pm CT, Wednesday, May 17.

Change of Entry

As described in Chapter 1, Section 21 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, a dog which is entered in a Novice A class for which it is not eligible may be moved to Novice B. In addition, if notification has been received in writing from the AKC after closing that a dog is not eligible for a class entered, the dog may be moved to the correct class. The request for the move must be made at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. If a VMO or Field Representative at a trial measures a dog into a height other than what they entered, the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to Regular, as long as the dog has not run any classes that day. If the dog has already run, the change may be made for the next trial day(s). The exhibitor must provide the Trial Secretary the AKC Agility Measurement Form when requesting the class change.

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day. Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A **separate entry form must be submitted** when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run. Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score.

For Exhibition Only (FEO) - FEO WILL BE OFFERED AT THIS TRIAL

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time to Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If
 the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for
 that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are
 not allowed. The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO
 may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board)

Trial Information

- -Setup time on Tuesday will be announced after closing.
- -Trial hours are 7:00 am to 30 minutes after completion.
- -Ring size: 90' x 105'.
- -Electronic timing will be used at these trials.
- -The building is climate-controlled. There is plenty of close parking and crate space.
- -Please bring chairs and crates.
- -Crating in designated areas only. Plastic ground cover required under crates.
- -NO SMOKING or VAPING is allowed in the building.
- -Dogs may not be left in the building overnight.
- -No outside food or beverages may be brought into the Event Center.

Prizes and Awards

For the Wednesday and Thursday trials, ribbons will be awarded to First Place through Fourth Place in each jump height in each class. For Friday, Armetale Day, Rosettes will be awarded to First Place through Fourth Place in each jump height in each class.

Rottweilers receiving a placement in any class will be given a voucher to present to the Awards Chair table.

Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score.

A qualifying score is required for all prizes offered in all classes at these trials.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by Event Committee action.
- American Rottweiler Club may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials can't be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the organizing committee's control.
- ARC will not be responsible for loss or damage to property while on the show site.
- Since bitches in season are not allowed to compete in AKC Agility Trials, the club will refund all but \$5 (for administrative fees) of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for that reason. Written documentation from a veterinarian must be presented prior to the start of judging on the first day the dog is entered. Such refunds will be mailed 3-4 weeks after the trial.
- The club will refund all but \$5 (for administrative fees) of the entry fee per run for serious illness/injury to dog/handler. Written documentation from veterinarian/physician must be delivered to the Trial Secretary within one week after the trial. Such refunds will be mailed 3-4 weeks after the trial.
- It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children cause unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund will be made.
- Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the AKC Agility Trials show grounds.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of
 internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate
 vaccinations.
- All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge
 need not wait for any dog holding up a class. ARC has no obligation or responsibility for
 providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or
 locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required. Please be considerate of your
 fellow exhibitors.
- Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must enter their JH# and complete back of form.
- All owners of mixed breed dogs must first obtain an AKC Canine Partners listing number before they may enter an AKC Agility event. The dog's breed name should be entered as "All American Dog". The dog's listing number must be entered on the entry form and "AKC" No. checked.
- Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or entries' cancellation after the published closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.
- Please **print legibly**. Incomplete and/or illegible entry forms cannot be accepted.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25 returned check fee.
- No refunds will be issued for overpayment of less than \$10.
- Checks for canceled or unacceptable entries will be shredded. No check will be returned.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Any exhibitor failing to do so may
 be excused without a refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor has violated this
 requirement.
- Exhibitors are required to observe Purina Event Center rules and regulations.



INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
